

Audio Recordings FAQs

Q: What is available for purchase?

A: We have a selection of CDs from past Conference talks for sale in the tent. Digital recordings of 2019 Pavilion talks and Breakout Sessions (pending author permissions) will be posted on the SVWC website for free after Conference.

NOTE: CDs of 2019 talks will only be available by special order AFTER Conference.

Q: How much do the CDs cost?

A: \$15 for individual talks (CD only)

\$150 for the 20th Anniversary Collection (CD portfolio or flash drive)

\$125 for an annual collection (CD portfolio or flash drive)

*Collections and 2019 CDs are only available AFTER Conference. Shipping is included in the price.

Q: Are recordings from past Conferences available?

A: Yes, please refer to the Archive List at the Info Desk. We have a selection of CDs from past years for sale in the SVWC Tent. If we do not have something in stock, you can fill out a special order form and leave it at the Info Desk to be shipped to you after Conference. Additionally, you can listen to 2016 - 2018 talks for free in the Audio Archive on our website, as well as the collection of "SVWC Classics" from the last 25 years.

Q: How do I purchase the 2019 collection?

A: Collections for the current year are put together only AFTER Conference via special order. Please fill out a special order form and give it to the Info Desk in the SVWC Tent.

Q: Can I purchase talks on a flash drive?

A: Yes. Collections (not individual talks) are available to purchase on a flash drive only AFTER Conference. Please indicate your preference on the special order form.

Q: Can I purchase recordings of Breakout Sessions?

A: Many of the Breakout Session recordings from 2016 - 2018 are now available for free in the Audio Archive on our website. Breakout session recordings from 2019 (for which we receive author permissions) will be posted on our website for free a few weeks AFTER Conference.

Q: Do you record every talk from each year?

A: We are lucky enough to have almost 100% participation from our presenters, however sometimes agents and publishers do not want talks to be recorded. We are only permitted to sell/post talks for which the presenter has signed a release.

Q: Who gets the money from the sales of audio recordings?

A: All proceeds from our sales support the Sun Valley Writers' Conference, an Idaho nonprofit 501(c)(3) corporation.
